<b>PURPOSE:</b>	To define the process of verification of preceptor board certification

**POLICY:**

The DPAS holds that supervised clinical practice experiences should occur with physicians who are specialty board certified in their area of instruction, or NCCPA certified PAs or other licensed healthcare providers qualified in their area of instruction. The DPAS makes every effort to ensure that this occurs. The department administrative secretary will maintain the preceptor files and required verification via copies of the provider's certificate or electronic verification.

The DPAS makes and documents every effort by the clinical faculty to secure rotations with board certified preceptors. These efforts include contacting all established
